

**\*Authors Guideline \***

- 1) For the book – “Living in the 21st Century World: Perspective on Climate Change, Pandemic, and Digital Transformation” Each chapter shall be at least 15 pages long, Arial 11 single-spaced and justified. Where there is the need for a short chapter, please confirm with the project Lead.
- 2) Key sections should include a synopsis of chapter, introduction, context, field examples, discussion issues, and references. Context shall vary depending on the topic and the author's style of writing.
- 3) All references shall be current except for seminal articles. Each chapter should have at least 20 relevant references. Use APA 7<sup>th</sup> edition for referencing.
- 4) Authors are responsible for any consent and or copyright approval for any insertions, pictures, and images in their chapters.
- 5) Images should be submitted as Attachment in jpg and tables must be properly referenced and checked for balance/alignment.
- 6) An author can work on two or more topics.
- 7) Each chapter topic could be slightly modified to meet the desire of the author - but the content shall be relevant to the entire book project
- 8) An attempt should be made to cover all segments of the topic with global, regional, and national perspectives and references.
- 9) Work should be presented in the third person
- 10) Authors should submit a brief synopsis and outline of their proposed chapters to the Project Team [@bookcontributor@waadinc.org](mailto:@bookcontributor@waadinc.org) for approval before commencing context development.
- 11) The author is free to engage qualified co-authors in the execution of their segments where it becomes necessary.
- 12) We anticipate the draft manuscript to be ready in 3 months.
- 13) Start date for writing of draft 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022 and expected submission of draft is May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
